*We hope that this small act of kindness will bring a little joy to your day and we hope that you know that we are thinking of you. Stay safe & have a lovely day.*



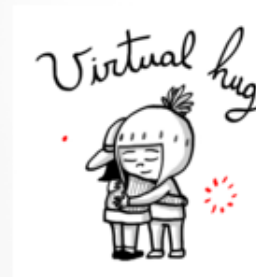

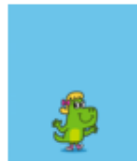
From the bottom

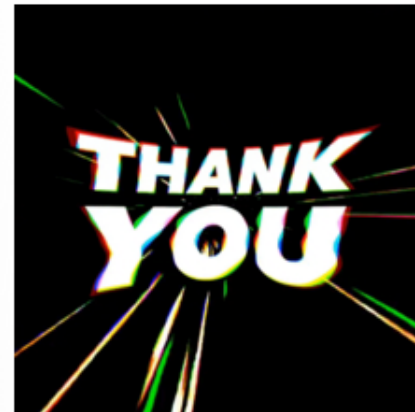
